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Materials

- Worsted weight yarn in white, red, and green
- Crochet hook size H/8 (5mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Gauge

4 stitches per inch in single crochet

Difficulty Level

Beginner

Pattern

Cap

1. With white yarn, chain 4 and join to form a ring.
2. Round 1: Single crochet 8 into the ring. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet.
3. Round 2: Chain 2 (counts as a single crochet), single crochet 2 into each stitch around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet.
4. Round 3: Chain 2, single crochet 2 into the first stitch, *single crochet 1 into the next stitch, single crochet 2 into the next stitch*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet.
5. Round 4: Chain 2, single crochet 2 into the first stitch, *single crochet 2 into the next stitch, single crochet 1 into the next stitch*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet.
6. Repeat rounds 3-4 until the cap measures 6 inches in diameter.
7. Round 7: Chain 2, single crochet 2 into the first stitch, *single crochet 3 into the next stitch, single crochet 1 into the next stitch*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet.
8. Round 8: Chain 2, single crochet 2 into the first stitch, *single crochet 4 into the next stitch, single crochet 1 into the next stitch*; repeat from *

around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet.

9. Repeat rounds 7-8 until the cap measures 8 inches in diameter.
10. Round 10: Chain 2, single crochet 2 into the first stitch, *single crochet 5 into the next stitch, single crochet 1 into the next stitch*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet.
11. Round 11: Chain 2, single crochet 2 into the first stitch, *single crochet 6 into the next stitch, single crochet 1 into the next stitch*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet.
12. Finish off and weave in ends.

Bib

1. With red yarn, chain 50.
2. Row 1: Single crochet into each stitch across.
3. Row 2: Chain 2, turn, single crochet into each stitch across.
4. Repeat row 2 until the bib measures 6 inches in length.
5. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Embroidery

To embroider the face on the cap, use black yarn and a yarn needle. Embroider two eyes, a nose, and a mouth.

To embroider the holly leaves on the bib, use green yarn and a yarn needle. Embroider three leaves on each side of the bib.

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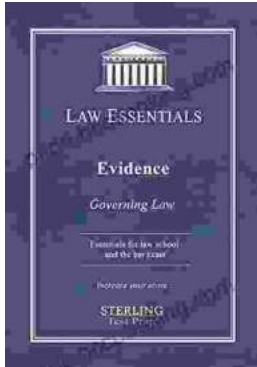
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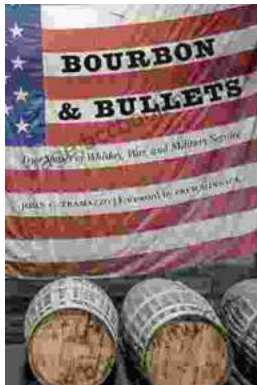
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
