


Janet Yellen: A Remarkable Rise to Power and Her Drive to Spread Prosperity to All

After teaching economics at the University of California, Berkeley, and the London School of Economics, Yellen joined the Federal Reserve Board of Governors in 1994. She served as president of the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco from 2004 to 2010, and as vice chair of the Federal Reserve from 2010 to 2014.






