
About the Author

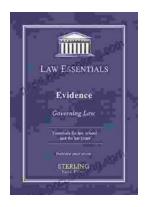
