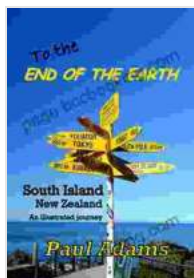


The Epic Antarctic Expedition of Ernest Shackleton

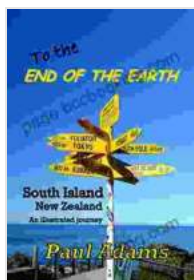

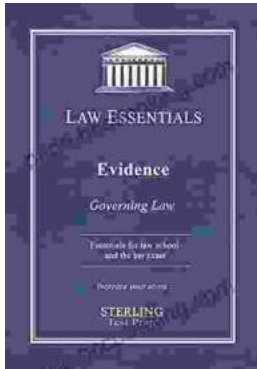

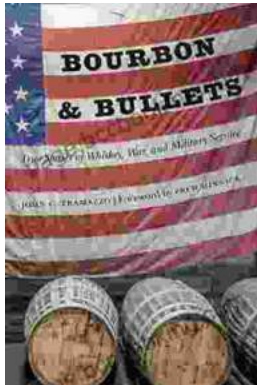
