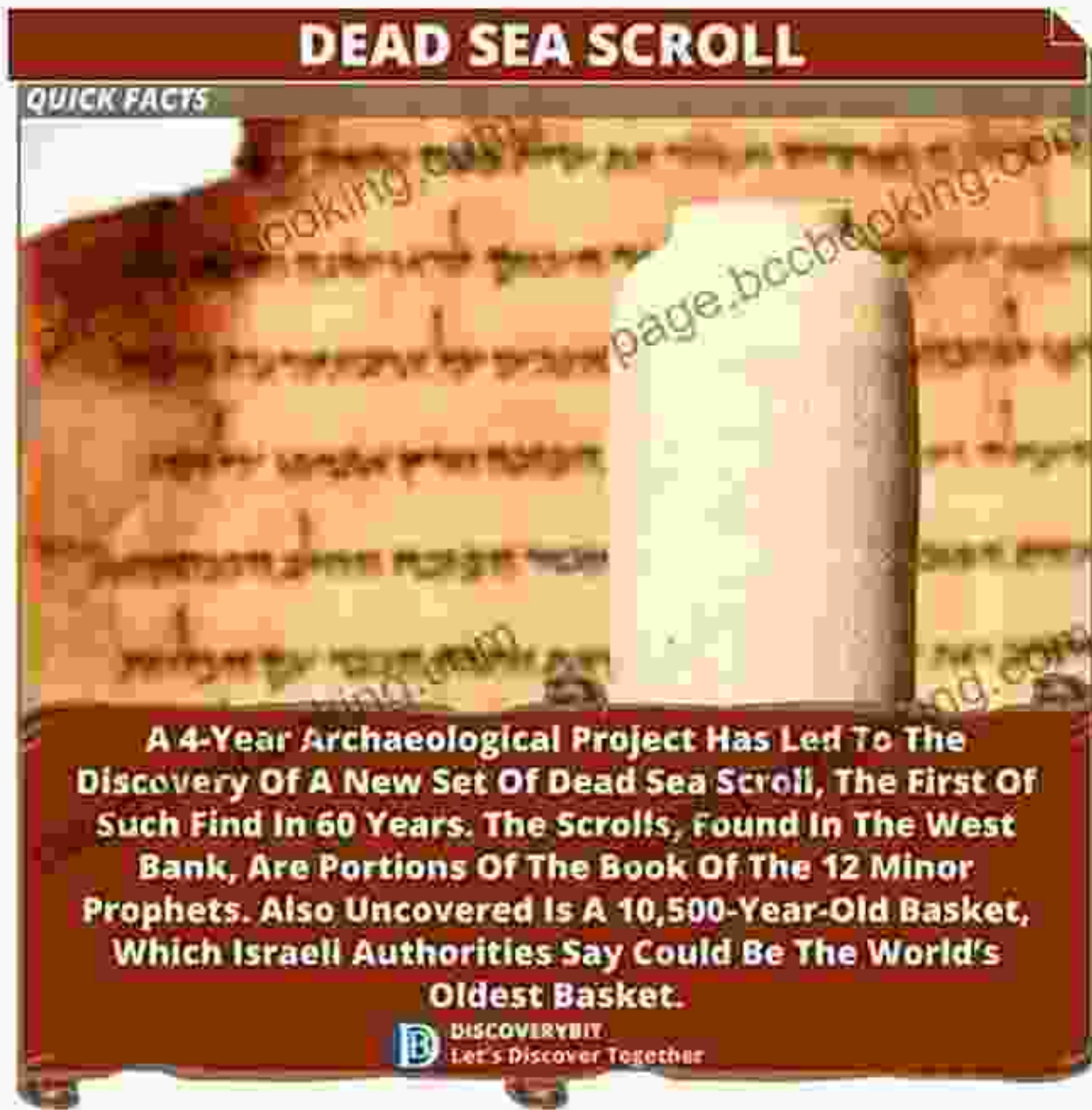


Figure 4: The Dead Sea Scrolls

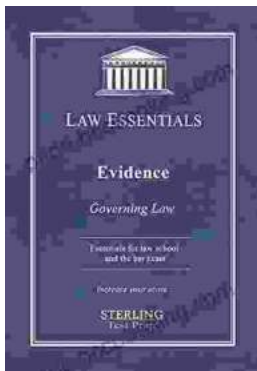

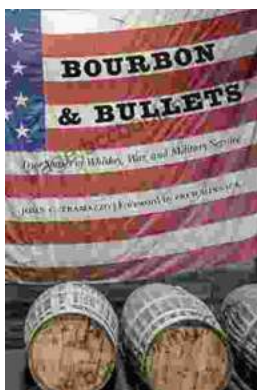
